Call to Order

Chair Bob Singer called the meeting to order at 10:12 am.

Credentials Report

Secretary Sarah Strickland reported that we have 89 member associations representing 111 votes. For the AGM, 33 associations represent 56 votes; of the 12 executive boards, 11 members are present, with 67 votes. A quorum was established with 111 total votes, with 66 currently present and needed. Arturo Cruz, who was present before voting began The majority of total votes needed to ratify is 63.

The majority of votes present were needed to ratify 32.

Minutes of the 2023 Mid-Year Meeting

Mebane Youth Soccer Association President Alan Huffman moved to approve the minutes of the Mid-Year Meeting.

Transylvania Youth Soccer Association President Joe Felty seconded the motion. Bob Singer called for a vote, and the motion was passed unanimously.

Actions of the Board

Mebane Youth Soccer Association President Alan Huffman moved to ratify the board's actions.

North Carolina Youth Soccer Association Annual General Meeting Greensboro Coliseum January 28, 2024 10:00 am Executive Board Director Large Clubs John Dalpe seconded the motion.

Chair Bob Singer called for a vote, passing the motion unanimously.

Executive Board Director of Large Clubs, John Dalpe, moved to ratify actions due to missing minutes of a special meeting to approve the revised budget on September 30th. Executive Board Vice-Chair Demp Bradford explained the meeting reformatted the budget, reflecting the actual budget and profit loss statement per program.

Triangle United Soccer Association President Cameron Tew moved to approve. Mebane Youth Soccer Association President Alan Huffman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously

Officer Reports

Chair Bob Singer updated on US Youth and US Club partnering potential. Groups are currently in discussion but have yet to create a specific plan.

Executive Board Director Recreation Rick Pierce reaffirmed his report on the program, noting growth in the recreation program with an additional four clubs in the process of joining. MOJO represented online to various coach levels for lesson plans and training schedules, TOP Soccer-2 new programs.

Executive Board Director Competitive Larry Taylor shared that the competitive program has increased numbers to 257 teams, returning to several teams pre-COVID-19- The competitive council will review forfeits and impact on teams; Electronic passes are continuing to go well. Noted appreciation for Colby and her efforts with competitive leagues. Regarding Discipline and Appeals, 2023 saw a major uptick in discriminatory language, with ten reported incidents. NCYSA D&A instituted a differentiation of Discriminatory language to ensure we adapt to how players use these types of terms and the language being used. This allows for clearer classification when issuing suspensions for these types of offenses.

- Coaching and Spectator Incidents were a priority in 2023 and will continue to be in 2024. With 40 Coach or

For spectator incidents, we are working to implement additional steps that will require coaches and spectators to

complete a Behavior Modification Course before returning to the field and while they are serving their

suspension to reinforce the need to remain professional and positive on the sidelines.

Executive Board Director of Tournaments Susanne Conlon was absent but submitted a report noting the Kepner Presidents Cup dates, upcoming Spring State Cup dates with seeding, and preliminary and final four weekends. Susanne thanked all volunteers and staff, especially Colby Morton, for their hard work.

Executive Board Player and Coaching Development, Art Rex, shared gratitude for Bill Furjanic and Jamie McLeod. He noted the absence of John Trice due to ODP. Art shared metrics of the successful academy event, opening ODP friendlies, and upcoming calendar of events, including coaching licenses hosted by the North Carolina Youth Soccer Association.

Director at Large, Boxley Llewellyn, submitted a report on parent behavior and methods to reinforce, modify, and empower others to report behavior. Growth was the second emphasis, looking at ways to retain participants. Strategy meetings reinforced the need to grow the game by looking at underserved communities. Soccer Starts at Home program to target 2-5-year-olds to introduce the game.

Risk Management, Boxley Llewellyn, presented the risk management report and noted Wendy Burns's work to maintain records on SafeSport and background check requirements. The NCYSA Executive Board voted to increase the fee incurred by member associations to process a background check

report from \$7 to \$10, effective with the 2024-25 seasonal year. This fee has never been increased since its inception in

2006. The cost for NCYSA to process a background check report has risen 58% since 2018 alone.

Director Small Associations, Stef Hamilton, did not share a report.

Director Medium Associations, Mike Martin, shared on running non-profit clubs and checklists to run clubs with terms and fiduciary expectations. Mike reviewed new research on providing benefits to members through collective pricing.

Director Large Associations, John Dalpe, supported the desire to grow member organizations. A recognized workshop that provided support to learn and collaborate to raise the level of soccer and professionalism of organizations.

SRA/SYRA Paul James' report submitted indicated the need to grow the referee base and financial support for referee training. Currently, there are 1200 registered referees for the current year.

Additional Reports

State Registrar, Jane Llewellyn, shared gratitude for the support of registrars from organizations to certify players to participate. Currently on pace to return to pre-pandemic numbers but are waiting for recreation numbers. Jane recognized staff Cindy Lineback for her 15 years of service and retirement.

Vice Chair, Demp Bradford, shared appreciation for staff members for their service. Demp noted the plan to update job descriptions, staff evaluations, and compensation structure for staff. Vice

Chair Demp Bradford thanked Executive Board Director of Large Clubs, John Dalpe, for serving on the finance committee.

Treasurer, Alberto Cruz, reported the Financials Report shared updates on the balance sheet, noting the stability of accounts. Another update is 1050 Accounts receivable; the other is government funding for staff retention. The profit and loss statement noted the registration fees account for 2030 reported an increase of \$380,000 compared to last year. Expenses have remained consistent. The net income on books is time-based and will adjust by year's end. Currently on track for a healthy budget close. Discussion followed.

Executive Board Director of Large Clubs, John Dalpe, moved to accept the agenda as presented. NC Fusion Proxy Scott Wollaston seconded the motion. The discussion opened for a motion. President Singer returned to the agenda as presented.

Amendment and Reinstatement of Bylaws

Motion to adopt amended bylaws sent out by Executive Director of Large Clubs John Dalpe, seconded by Triangle United Soccer Association President Cameron Tew. Discussion followed. Art Rex moved to table motion proposed by Chair Bob Singer. Triangle United Soccer Association President Cameron Tew seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Dennis Seashore moved to vote on the motion to table the edits. The majority passed it.

John Dalpe moved to consider proposed changes to the amendment and restatement of bylaws. Triangle United Soccer Association President Cameron Tew seconded the proposal. Discussion followed. John Dalpe withdrew the motion presented.
